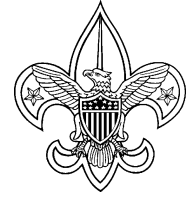

# Leave No Trace Trainer Course

### WHY ATTEND?

Learn more in-depth about the seven principles of Leave No Trace and best practices for implementing them in a hands-on environment, including how to teach them to others.

### WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Scouts and Venturers age 14 and older, crews attending treks at Philmont or Northern Tier, adult Scout leaders in all programs (Cub Scouting, Scouts BSA, Venturing, Sea Scouting), summer camp staff, Campmasters, District & Council training team members

### COURSE CONTENT:

- How to minimizing impact in the outdoors by making informed and conscientious decisions
- Hands-on activities and games to illustrate the importance and meaning of the Leave No Trace principles
- Backcountry techniques, such as how to select a campsite, hang and use a bear bag, dig a cat hole, dispose of dishwater, and build a mound fire
- Effective ways to teach others about Leave No Trace, including teaching presentations by all participants
