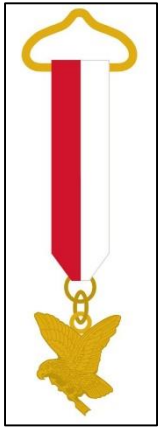




Nentico Centennial Award

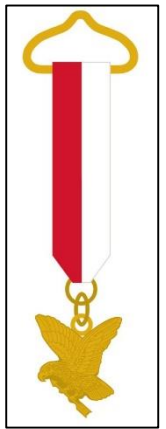
