- Successful completion of the NRA Basic Pistol Course is a prerequisite for this course. Students must also complete the NRA Basic Instructor Training (BIT) as well. BIT for this course will occur the morning of 10/26. Anyone who has completed a BIT course in the last 2 years should contact the instructor if they do not want to repeat it.
- Coffee, Snacks & Lunch will be provided. Please inform us of any Food Allergies. Students are encouraged to bring a travel mug or cup and a water bottle.
- All student manuals and handouts will be provided. Students are encouraged to bring additional note taking supplies if they wish. Some students find a highlighter helpful.
- All firearms, ammunition and safety equipment needed for the course will be provided. No personally owned firearms or ammunition will be allowed at the training venue.
