



### Broad Creek Memorial Scout Reservation

POSITION: CONSERVATION / ECOLOGY (ConEc) DIRECTOR (18 or older)

REPORTS TO: Program Director

SUPERVISES: Conservation / Ecology Instructors

#### ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Must be National Camping School (NCS) certified or attend NCS and receive certification as ConEc Director.
2. Must have all BSA ConEc related Merit Badges or equivalent experience.
3. Must be able to train, supervise and evaluate the ConEc Staff.
4. Must be able to properly use all BCMSR ConEc equipment.
5. Must be able to instruct Scouts/staff in all aspects of ConEc activities and instruction.
6. Work closely with the Camp Ranger and Council Conservation Committee in planning and completing all conservation projects.
7. Must be able to develop lesson plans for all advancement opportunities at ConEc.

#### GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Keep the area in and around ConEc clean, neat safe and organized.
2. Report any maintenance needs to the Program Director.
3. Ensure that all living creatures are well cared-for and that any creatures captured are released without harm.
4. Ensure that all equipment used for all projects is well-maintained, used properly, and returned after use.
5. Complete all required inventories.
6. Request all program materials in a timely manner.
7. Provide a friendly and helpful welcome to all visitors and customers.
8. Abide by all policies as per the Staff Guidebook.
9. Carry out such projects as will improve the camp's operation during the summer and in future years.
10. Complete all additional duties as assigned.
