RULES AND REGULATIONS

Groups must check in prior to set up.

All event participants are reminded that the Arrowhead District Camporee is being held on private religious camp property and as such, all of us are personal guests of Pearlstone Center. All participants must conform to the requirements as specified by the site owner. Everyone's cooperation is expected and appreciated.

**There are not trash facilities at Pearlstone Center.
All trash must be brought out when your units leave.**

Alcoholic Beverages and Drugs – Possession and/or use of alcoholic beverages or drugs are prohibited. You will be evicted from the Arrowhead District Camporee if found with either.

Smoking – National Policy states that smoking is not only a safety hazard, but also objectionable in the presence of youth. Therefore, smoking will not be permitted in Camp areas. The designated smoking area is at the far end of the parking lot down the hill. There will be no smoking allowed if Scouts are in sight of the area.

Electronic Devices – Radios, video games, etc, are not permitted at Pearlstone Center.

Responsibility – There must be at least two (2) adult leaders in camp responsible for their units at all times. A minimum of one adult leader and the SPL from each unit are expected to attend Friday and Saturday night's Leaders Meetings. All units with female Scouts must have a female adult present in camp.

Off Limit Areas – All Youth participants will confine themselves to the campsite area. Known off limit areas will be discussed at Friday night's Leaders meeting.

Fire Pits and Rain Trenches – Do not dig holes or trenches. Only "above the ground fires" in drums or barrels will be allowed. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Vehicles – Only emergency vehicles (as designated by the Staff) will be allowed in Camp. All other vehicles must be parked in the designated parking areas.

Uniforms – Field Uniforms (aka Class 'A' uniforms) are required for assemblies, meetings, religious services. All other activities are subject to weather conditions as to uniforms.

Early Departures – In the event that any registered Adult Leader or Scout must leave the Arrowhead District Camporee/site for any reason, please notify one of the Staff or Area Director(s).

Pearlstone Center permanent restroom facilities are for adult use only! The Spot-A-Pots are for Adult/Scout use and guests that come up on Saturday.

Sheath Knives serve no useful purpose at the Arrowhead District Camporee and, therefore, are not permitted. They will be confiscated by Staff or Area Director(s) if found.

It is requested that patrols complete each activity station only once. If they complete a station more than once, they will not receive additional beads for that completion.

Constructive suggestions for improvements of Arrowhead District Camporee are welcome at the Saturday Night Leaders Meeting.
